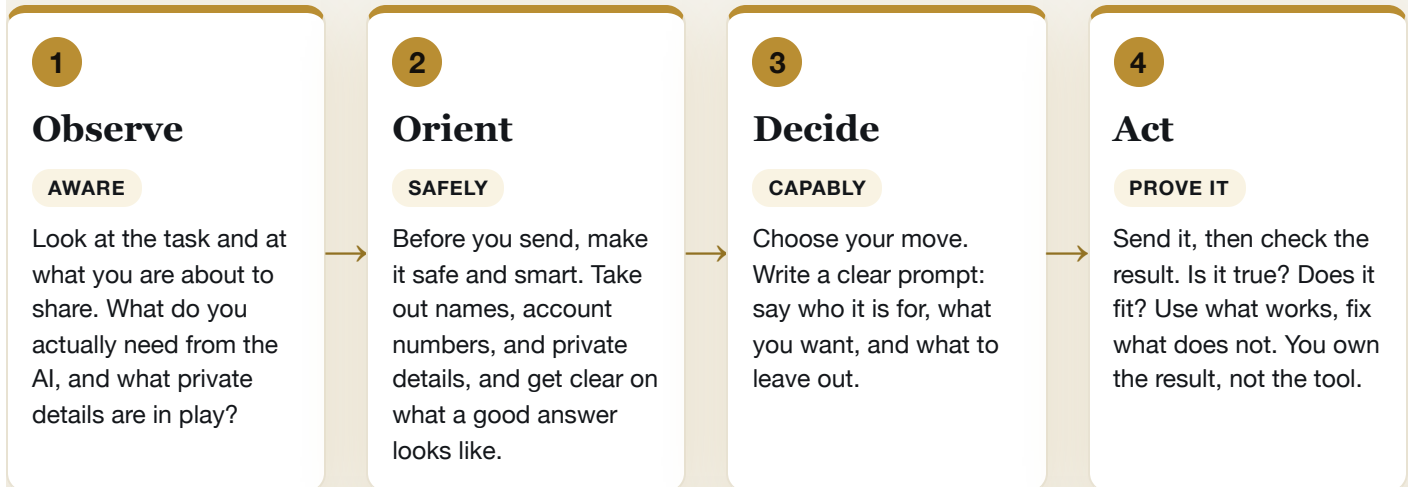


Work with AI: the OODA Loop

Observe · Orient · Decide · Act — run it every time

AI is only as good as the person driving it. Borrow the loop fighter pilots use to think fast under pressure. Run it every time you use an AI tool and you stay safe, get better answers, and can trust what you keep.



↳ Then loop again — the faster and sharper you cycle, the more you get out of AI.

Where this goes next: you will run this exact loop live when you connect your own AI in **Claude Foundations**. The awareness course teaches the loop; Foundations is where you fly it on real work.
